### **Terms**

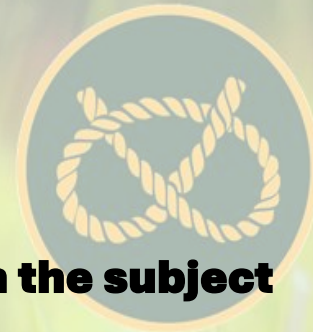
